


Canyonlands White Rim Trail

Roads spatial datasets were: US Census Bureau 2010. Structures: traced from NAIP. Cartographic omissionsand/or improvements will be periodically included/addressed as future update versions.

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White Rim Trail I divided into three Parts (officially, it is not). This makes describing each section more spatially meaningful:

Average slope varies from 2.3% to 6.7%; Mileage is ~ 38.75 miles

Average slope varies from 4.4% to 7.9%; the 2 mile Exit Ascent is an arduous 15% to 24% slope Mileage is ~ 12.8 miles

White Rim Trail Part 2:

Average slope varies from 1.7% to 8.4%; Mileage is ~ 22.84 miles
